If your child failed one or more classes, you have four options to make up the credit. Before registering for any options, we recommend speaking with Mrs. Boyer or Mrs. Finch in the counseling office.

OPTION 1:

The School District of Philadelphia will again be sponsoring a **Credit Recovery Summer School** for presently enrolled students of the School District of Philadelphia in grades 11 and 12 for free.

12th GRADE PARTICIPANTS:

Can recover up to 2 classes and/or their Multi-Disciplinary Project.
They have courses available to them in all graduation areas.
As there will be a graduation exercise please remind students to bring their GOWNS.

11th GRADE PARTICIPANTS:

Can recover up to 2 classes in one of the following graduation areas:
English, History, Math or Science.

Option 2

Sunrise of Philadelphia will offer a free summer credit recovery program at the following location for students in the grades 9-12 from July 3- August 11:

Philadelphia, PA 19148

Classes will be held during 4 different sessions: 8-9:30 am, 9:30-11 am, 11-12:30 pm, and 12:30-2 pm, Monday-Friday in room 316. Students will need to pick 1 time slot to attend. Multiple courses can be taken during the assigned time slot.

Applications can be returned to South Philadelphia High School, Room 312B to Keyonis Johnson until June 16, 2017. We will have an orientation on June 13th and June 15th @ 4:00 p.m. in room 316. Students interested in attending the program should attend one of the orientation dates. Students who attend the orientation will be given preference of choosing a time slot. Please make sure applications are filled out completely. We will not accept incomplete applications. OPTIONS 3 & 4

9th through 11th grade students who wish to recover credits this summer have the following options.
These programs offer credit recovery opportunities for a fee.

All high schools, will accept Recovery credits for students who successfully complete coursework at one of the two programs listed below. These schools offer courses led by certified instructors in the core areas of English, Math, History, Science and World Language. Grades will be entered by Central Office at the conclusion of their respective programs.
